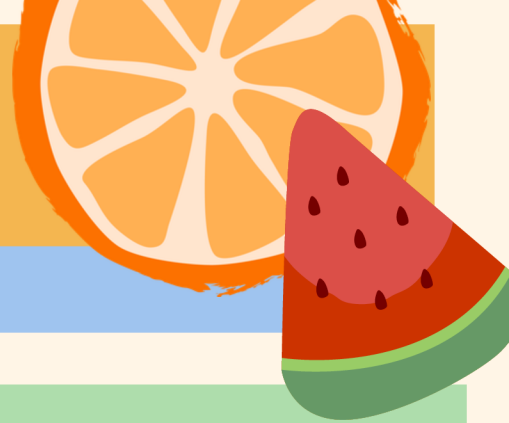

## English

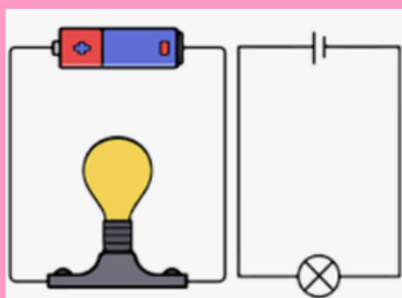
In our Guided Reading sessions we will be reading *How to train your dragon* by Cressida Cowell.
